The name

Chorion evokes the Byzantine origins of Terre di Corillo. Indeed, it once referred to a rural settlement which inspired the name of this estate.

A symbol of how the history of a place is important to making its future authentic and credible.

Grapes and terroir

This wine's perfect equilibrium was achieved by using a blend of grapes, with 60% from Negroamaro vines, and 40% from Primitivo vines. The typical Salento soil, with its characteristic red hue and its composition rich in metals, minerals, clay and lime, helps to shape this wine's identity and personality.

Cultivation and harvest method

Manual work, which is vital, is aided and enhanced day after day by the most modern viticulture systems to carefully tend the vines of Terre di Corillo. The grapes are harvested strictly by hand and placed in vented crates to preserve their integrity, before undergoing an additional, thorough selection process.

This ensures the finest quality, with the utmost respect for the environment and the end consumer.
